# Scattering Garden

*A Scattering Garden is a perfect opportunity to provide an alternate place for human remains following cremation and it is an alternative to urns. The use of a dedicated area on our church property assures the site will not be developed for other use at some future time.*

*St. Mark's Scattering Garden is a way to honor your loved one's wishes and have a permanent memorial to visit and pay their respects. The Scattering Garden offers a peaceful, serene place to come and reflect. St. Mark's Scattering Garden is located in our courtyard. The garden is enclosed with a beautiful black satin cross fence. Inside lays the cross garden with a ceramic angel overlooking. Sitting benches surround the garden for loved ones to visit.*

*You may choose to have a short Memorial Service or Life Celebration Service, which typically will include a biblical reading. You can discuss your choices with Pastor Tim to create a meaningful and personal ash scattering ceremony that can be customized to fit your family's specific desires. The service can be as formal or informal as you like. Family and/or friends are welcome to speak recalling fond memories, events and anecdotes from your loved one's life. Ashes are gently buried several inches into loose soil or you may choose to simply scatter the ashes of your loved one.*



*We ask that the three following documents be provided to St. Mark:*

*Copy of the Death Certificate, Signed Cremated Remains Release Form, Payment for services requested*

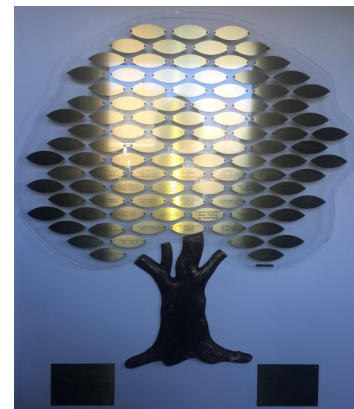
### **Fees:**

**\$150** - Scattering of Ashes at St. Mark, which can include a short service

**\$100** - Tree of Life Memorial Leaf, with inscription

### ***Tree of Life Memorial***

*You may purchase a memorial leaf that may have an inscription up to three lines. The leaf will become part of our Tree of Life Memorial which is displayed on the wall of our Christian School. The leaf may be purchased as a memorial or a record of interment.*
